JUDGMENT

On the 18.2.02 the parties took dates for hearing of this suit by consent to be heard on 24th and 25th June 2003. On the said day fixed for hearing, the suit was called out. The advocate for the plaintiff came late. The advocate for the defendant did not appear at all despite the court waiting for her. The proceeding proceeded the following day under order 9b r 3(a) CPR; namely that the court was satisfied that the defendant had notice of the hearing date but had failed to appear, the hearing is permitted to proceed ex pare.
